

# 2020 Choir Competition

# Rules and Registration

### Choir Competition Guidelines:

- Students will compete against students of all ages.
  - o The Choir Competition is not split up by level, age, or grade.
- ❖ Music selection should be a Madrigal piece chosen by the sponsor/director.
  - Pieces must be sung acapella without any accompanying music.
- ❖ Each performance will be limited to one music selection. Each school will be given 10 minutes on stage to warm up <u>and</u> perform your selection.
- ❖ An introduction at the beginning of the performance is required. The introduction shall include the name of the school and the music selection to be performed.
- ❖ Trophies will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places.
- Two complimentary Scarborough Renaissance Festival® tickets will be awarded to all competition participants.

#### Registration Information:

- ❖ Schools entering in the Choir Competition must purchase tickets in advance and be present at Student Days on April 28, 2020 to compete.
- ❖ The school must be registered to attend and paid in full no later than April 1, 2020.
- ❖ The sponsor/director shall provide the music selection to be performed (including copies of the music for competition judges) to the Student Days Coordinator no later than April 1, 2020.
- ❖ Intent to compete by completing the enclosed registration form must be received by the deadline of April 1, 2020. Please note that space is limited and competitors are registered on a first come first serve basis.

## Judging & Awards:

- ❖ Judges will consist of educators, performers, and staff members approved by Scarborough Renaissance Festival®. All judges' decisions are final.
- Students will compete against students of all ages. The Choir Competition is not split up by level, age, or grade.
- ❖ Judging will take place during the competition on April 28, 2020.

- ❖ Schools participating in this competition must check in at the Wedding Garden inside the Front Gate upon arrival at Student Days on April 28, 2020 by 9:30am. This is necessary for the school to be eligible to participate in the competition.
- ❖ Judging notes will be emailed electronically to the sponsor/director within 7 business days of Student Days.
- ❖ Awards will be given to the 1<sup>st</sup> place, 2<sup>nd</sup> place and 3<sup>rd</sup> place finalists. Awards will be presented to the winners at the Royal Awards Ceremony held during the Student Days schedule of events at 1:00pm on the Crown Stage.
- ❖ Two complimentary Scarborough Renaissance Festival® tickets will be awarded to all competition participants.
