

2020 Heraldry Competition


Rules and Registration

Goals:

❖ To create your own Coat of Arms (herald) to represent your school.

Heraldry Guidelines:

- ❖ Artist(s) may consist of individual students or groups of students working together.
- ❖ Each Coat of Arms must be 3' wide x 4' high (on material of choice) and must include:
 - o SHIELD: Shape of your choosing.
 - o HELM: Shape of your choosing.
 - MANTLE: Design that represents the protection between the armor and the helmet.
 - PARTING OF THE FIELD: These are the lines that divide your shield into sections. Must have at least 3 sections, but no more than 6.
 - CHARGES: These are symbols that represent something about your school.
 - o MOTTO: A word or phrase that represents your school.
 - COLORS: Use colors from the 16th century that represents your school.
 (Please remember that colors used were: White (Silver), Red, Yellow (Gold), Green, Blue, Purple and Black.)



This image is a guideline for creating a Coat of Arms. All pieces of the above example may be altered as long as each requirement is present as explained in the Guidelines.

- o School Name must be included somewhere on the Shield.
- o DISPLAY: Artist(s) are responsible for securing a hanging mechanism (string, rope, etc.) to the back of each Coat of Arms (12" 15" in length) as heralds will be displayed hanging on wooden dowels for judging. (Dowels will be supplied by Scarborough Renaissance Festival®).
- ❖ Each entry must securely attach, to the back of the banner, a 3x5 card with your school name, teachers name, address, daytime phone number, email address, and category.

Registration Information:

- ❖ Enclosed registration form declaring intent to compete must be received by the Student Days Department no later than April 1, 2020.
- Students entering in the Heraldry Competition must be present at Student Days on April 28, 2020 to win.
- ❖ The student's school must be registered and paid to attend Student Days at Scarborough Renaissance Festival® no later than April 1, 2020.

Judging & Awards:

- Artist(s) participating in this competition must check in, with your Heraldic Device, at the Wedding Garden inside the Front Gate upon arrival at Student Days on April 28, 2020 by 10:00am. This is necessary for the artist(s) to be eligible to participate in the competition.
- ❖ Anyone that shows up the April 28, 2020 and did not submit the intent to compete form by the deadline will be disqualified.
- Artist(s) will be escorted or directed to the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area after check in where heralds will be displayed for judging.
- ❖ Judges will consist of approved educators, performers, and staff members by Scarborough Renaissance Festival®. All judges' decisions are final.
- ❖ Trophies will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd place in each category.*All entries will be considered for Best in Show.
- ❖ Awards will be presented to the winners at the Royal Awards Ceremony held during the Student Days of events at 1:00pm on the Crown Stage.
- Heralds may be picked up after the Royal Awards Ceremony on Student Days in the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area.
- ❖ Any heralds remaining in the Village Green Corporate Picnic Area at 3:00pm will become property of Scarborough Renaissance Festival®.
